### Purpose of this data processing:

In addition, the Vienna University of Technology reserves the right to carry out further in-depth analyzes for scientific purposes. Results from the survey are only published in aggregated form, which do not allow any conclusions to be drawn about individual survey participants. The automatically collected data will not be passed on to third parties.

### Recipients of the data:

The survey is conducted via SurveyMonkey Europe UC, 2nd Floor, 2 Shelbourne Buildings, Shelbourne Road, Dublin, Ireland. The data is stored on SurveyMonkey servers in the EU and at the Vienna University of Technology. The storage locations are secured against unauthorized access.

The **legal basis** for this data processing is the fulfillment of a legal obligation in accordance with Art 6 Paragraph 1 c GDPR in conjunction with Section 3 UG and FOG (Research Organization Act).

### Duration of data storage:

As a research institution, the Vienna University of Technology is subject to different retention periods, which may make long-term storage of the data from the survey (up to 10 years) necessary.
